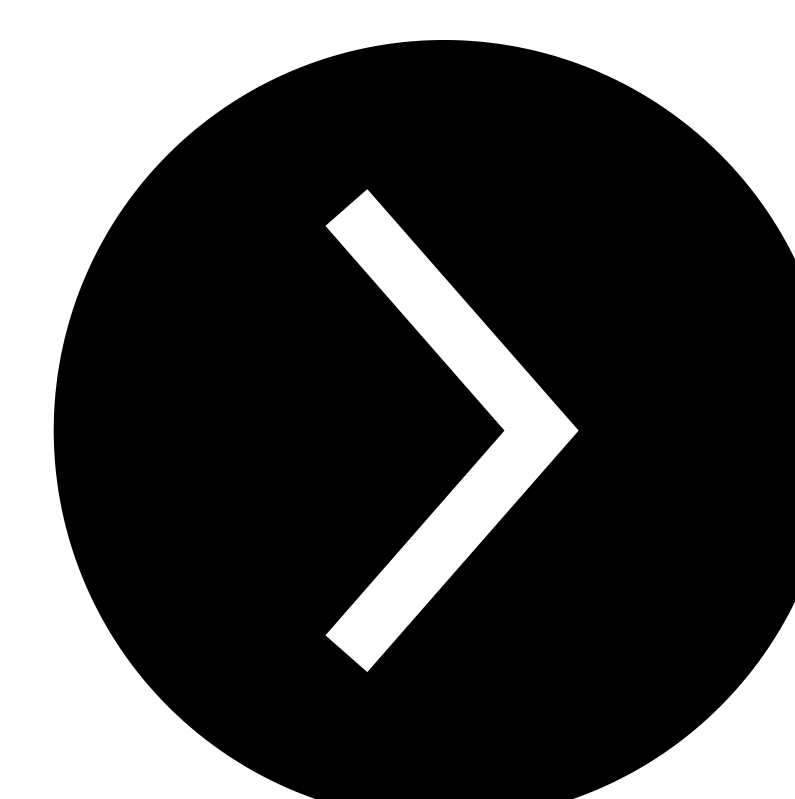

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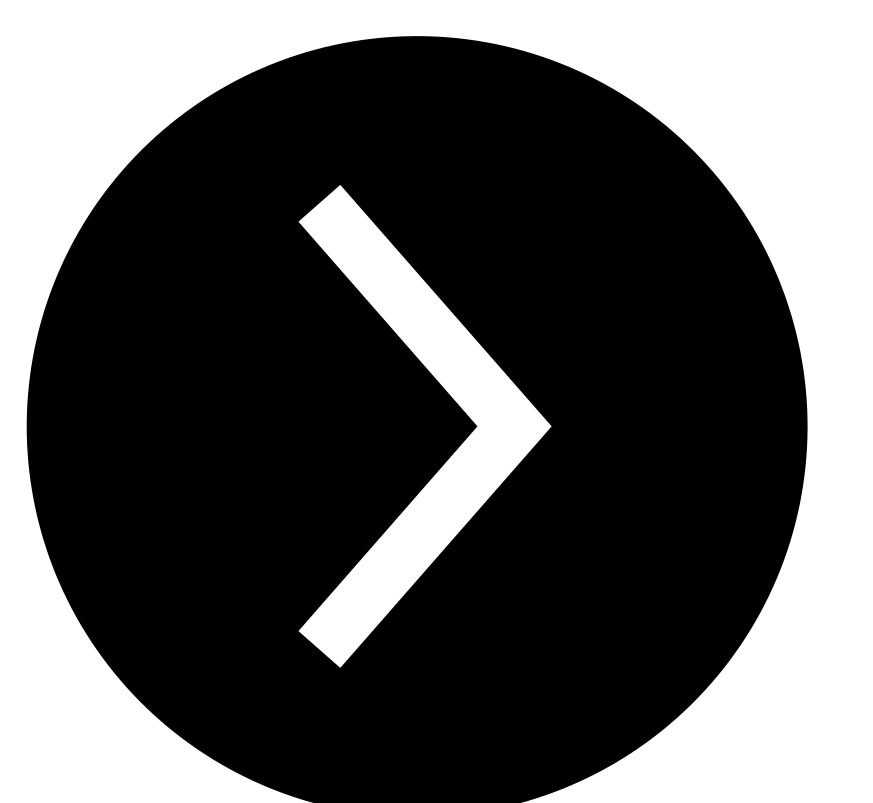

The challenge

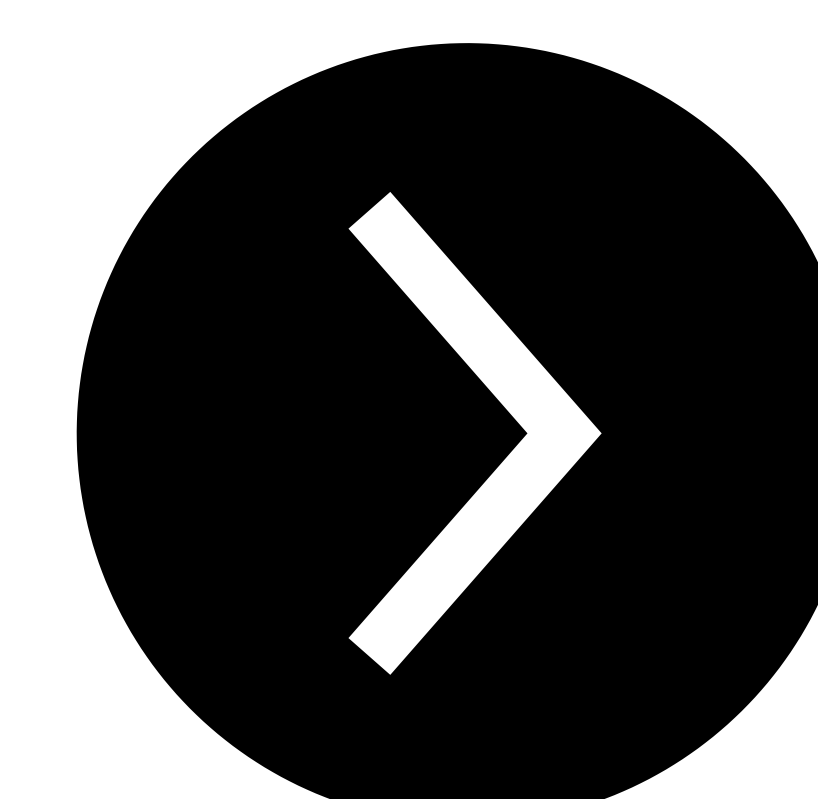
- Many students don't get the chance **to apply what they learn** to real problems.
- Young people from smaller regions have **limited access** to good innovation programmes, mentors and company connections.
- Companies often struggle **to find young talent** ready to work on complex challenges.
- The gap between education and labour market needs slows down the development of **future skills**.





The idea

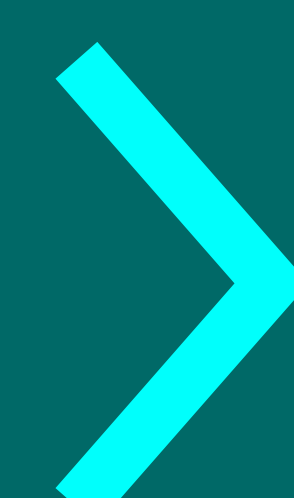
Digital Innovation Incubator is a Croatian initiative that helps students build future skills by connecting them with real business challenges through online learning, mentoring and project-based competition.





What's innovative here?


- **Fully digital model:** students from more than 100 towns can access quality content and real-world experience.
- **Real challenges:** partner companies provide concrete problems and take part in mentoring.
- **Human vs AI:** a format where students compete with AI and build confidence in using new technologies.
- **Structured development:** a mix of education, digital inclusion, talent development and AI literacy.



Impact so far

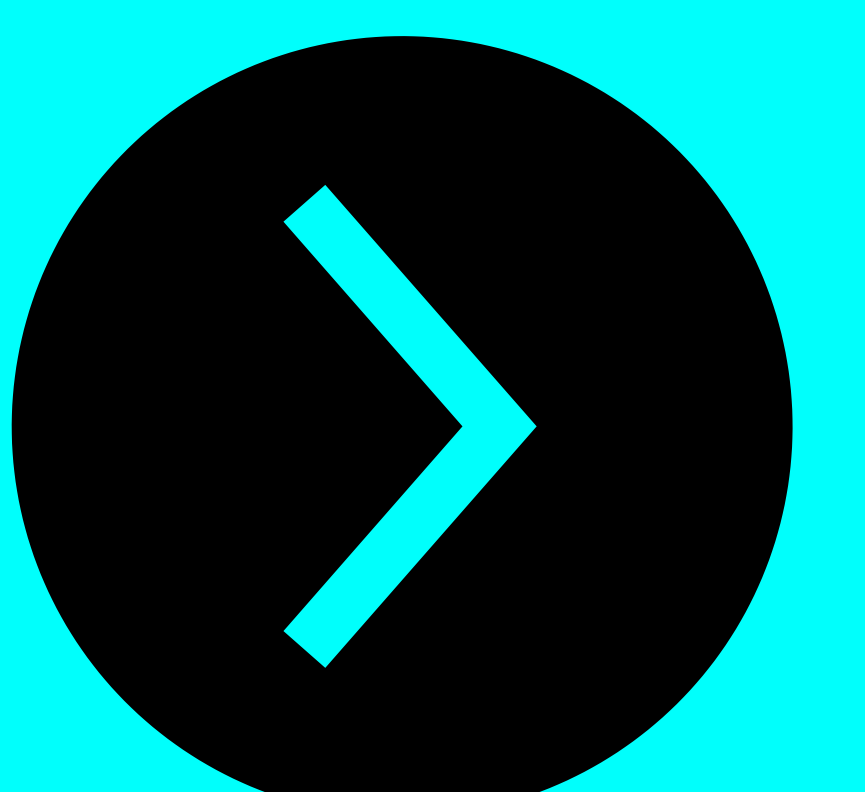
More than 8,500 students have hands-on  innovation experience.

Educators and schools are recognised through  the Innovation School award.

Participants come from more than 120  higher education institutions and 300 primary and secondary schools.






Impact so far

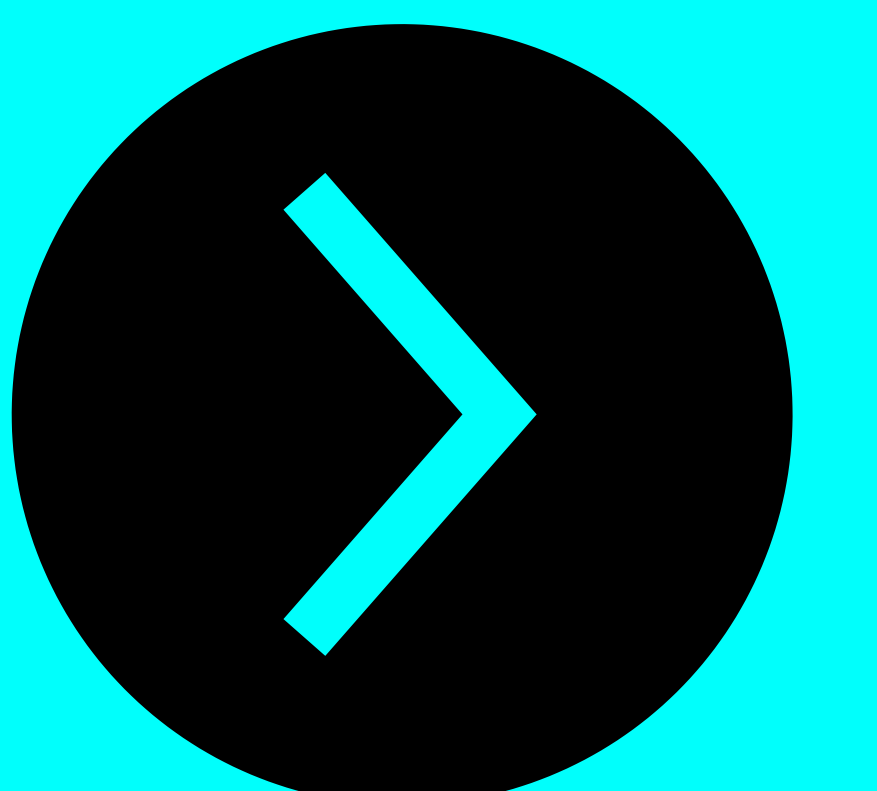
Educators benefit from practical,  high-impact learning.

Policymakers see progress in inclusion,  empowerment and talent retention, especially in underserved regions.



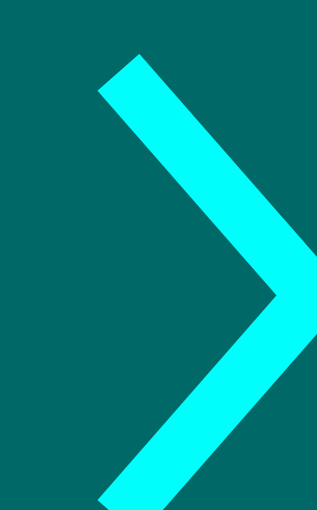
